Family of Christ Photo Directory

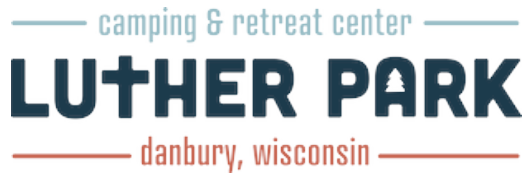
