- Raise awareness of community needs

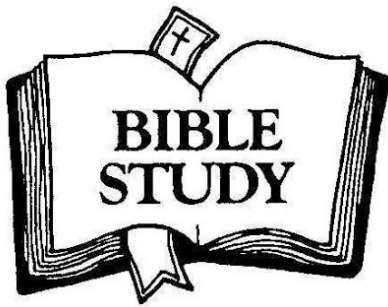
Weekly Education Opportunities Starting Soon for the 2026 - 2027 Year!
